simply use your Advantage Card. Every dollar spent will be credited to our school. If you spend $\$ 79.00$ or more (at one time), our school will receive double credit.

Every month, a Market Day flier will be sent home with your child. This is a wonderful fundraising program that not only benefits the school, but also benefits you with quality food products. To place an order, complete the order form and return it by the due date listed on the back of the flier. You can also place your order online at www.marketday.com.
